



INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA (GDPR) (RODO)

1. DATA CONTROLLER

The controller of personal data is Pineapple Therapy Julia Bieniasz-Bragiel and Krystian Bragiel civil partnership, with its registered office at Herbu Janina 11b/23, 02-972 Warsaw, Poland.

2. SCOPE OF PROCESSED DATA

The processed data may include:

- parent's or legal guardian's contact details,
- child's age and information related to communication, speech and articulation development provided in the questionnaires.

3. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

Personal data are processed for the purpose of:

- conducting a screening, orientation-level assessment of selected aspects of a child's communication and speech development,
- preparing and delivering written feedback to the parent or legal guardian,
- sharing feedback with the childcare institution, only if the parent or legal guardian provides explicit consent.

4. LEGAL BASIS FOR PROCESSING

The legal basis for processing personal data is the consent of the parent or legal guardian:

- Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR,
- Article 9(2)(a) of the GDPR (processing of special category data concerning a child's development).

5. VOLUNTARY NATURE OF DATA PROVISION

Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the screening initiative.

6. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Personal data will be stored for no longer than 12 months from the completion of the screening, unless consent is withdrawn earlier.

7. DATA RECIPIENTS

Personal data are not shared with third parties, except:





- with the childcare institution attended by the child, if the parent or legal guardian has given separate and explicit consent.

8. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

The parent or legal guardian has the right to:

- access the personal data,
- rectify the data,
- erase the data,
- restrict processing,
- withdraw consent at any time.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out before withdrawal.

9. RIGHT TO LODGE A COMPLAINT

The parent or legal guardian has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Polish Personal Data Protection Office (UODO).

10. AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING

Personal data are not used for automated decision-making or profiling.
